Background:

This one day training course provides participants with the required knowledge to be able to administer the approved child adaptation of the Eating Disorder Examination (EDE). The EDE is an investigator-based interview measure of the specific psychopathology of the eating disorders anorexia nervosa, bulimia nervosa and binge eating disorder. It is widely regarded as the gold-standard assessment measure available to clinicians and researchers.

Dr Bryant-Waugh is the recognised trainer on the child adaptation, which can be used by clinicians and researchers working with young people.

What the Programme Offers:

The training includes an orientation to the measure, its uses, how to generate a diagnosis, and an item by item discussion of content and ratings.

Key Outcome:

At the end of the training participants will have the skills and competencies required to be able to use the EDE with children and young people aged 8 years and older.
