Background:

The aim of this programme is to offer a masterclass in supervision for Maudsley Family Therapy for Eating Disorders (FT/ED) and Multifamily Therapy for Eating Disorders (MFT/ED). This Intensive masterclass, comprised of three half-days, will include basic principles of supervision, FT and MFT/ED specific supervision of supervision, and complex case discussion.

Aims of this Programme:

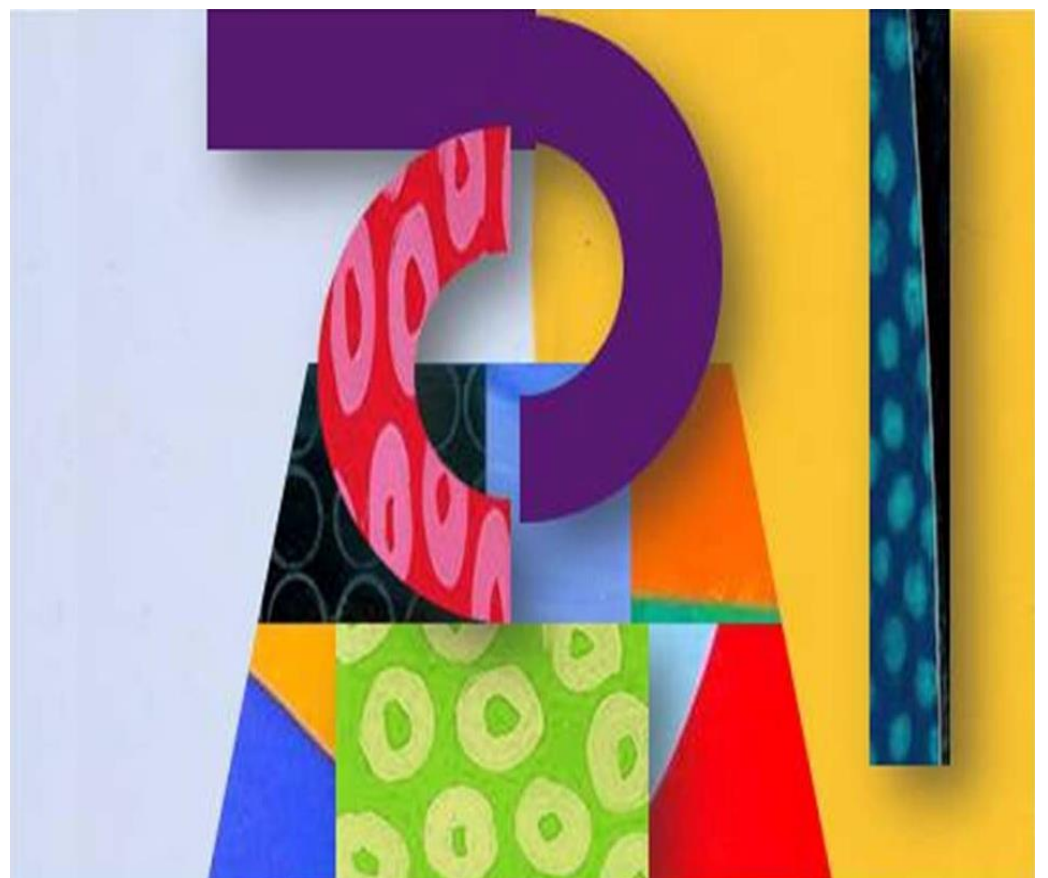
- To promote evidence-based practice in the treatment of Eating Disorder (NICE Guidelines, 2017).
- To discuss basic principles of supervision.
- To strengthen existing expertise of supervision of FT/ED and MFT/ED
- To provide participants with the skills, knowledge and confidence in order to apply this model to their relevant clinical setting.

What the Programme Offers:

The training consists of an intensive programme across 3 half-days with a combination of didactic and experiential components, including case discussion.

Key Outcome:

To strengthen existing expertise of supervision of FT/ED and MFT/ED and create a network of professionals with advanced skills in supervision for the above models and the opportunity for complex case discussion. It will offer 6 CPD points for qualified supervisors towards their accreditation requirements, and points for clinicians using APEL route for qualification. We recommend early booking to guarantee a place and thus avoid disappointment.



Cost:

3 half-days Masterclass

Who can Apply:

The programme is designed for experienced clinicians and supervisors, with significant experience in delivering FT-ED and MFT-ED and providing supervision for eating disorders multi-disciplinary teams. It can include experienced supervisors of FT-ED and MFT-ED from all disciplines (i.e. Psychiatrists, Family Therapists, Psychologists, Psychotherapists, and Nurse Specialists).
